Presidents Report June 2022

Following our last meeting I have been busy doing introductions to our surrounding MHA's, RHL and the Bisons.

- had a meeting with our operations manager Rachelle to discuss contract and how a few things run within FHMA.

- had a meeting / debrief with our Past President Kellie to discuss role and what things were left unaccomplished.

-working on our shared file system so everyone can access FMHA documents easily.

-working with Rachelle on getting our letterhead, email signatures, website colours changed over to represent out new flyers colours.

- Have been in communication with Bisons, Vulcan, Nanton and Okotoks on the U11-HADP project and attend a Hockey Alberta open house.



Equipment Director Report

The new jersey's have been ordered. From what I understand they will be in close to end of August. That doesn't leave much time for getting sponsorships logos on so we will try to organize the best we can to have everything ready to be in and out the door, so jersey's are ready to go out in time.

The prices of jersey's are \$58.99 per jersey. We have ordered 7 sets of jersey's. Each set has 25 homes and 25 aways. Price per set would be \$2,949.50 plus GST. Total cost of jerseys will be \$20,646 plus GST.

We have also ordered 370 sets of socks. That should be enough for all 7 teams and about 20 extras. Home and Away's 10 each. The cost per sock set is \$15.99 plus GST. Total for all socks will be \$5,916.30 plus GST.

Classic will also be carrying 20 extra Logos in case we need to get a jersey repaired our one ordered in.

Also they said they would stock extra socks in the store as well.

We have also ordered 4 boxes of pucks. One was left over old logos and 3 boxes of the new logos. That should last us throughout the year and if we have to get any more they will be blanks to keep the price down.

The price of old was \$2.69 per puck.

The price of new pucks was \$3.89.

Total cost of all pucks is \$718 plus GST.

I have spoken with Jim Walker. He has committed \$3,000 on behalf of Walker and Sons and \$6,000 on behalf of the Blackie Bobcats. He is working on the sponsorship logos himself and I will get him some jerseys to mock up. As well I have spoken to Rob about South Country Coop Sponsoring and it sounds like they will as well for \$3,000. I have to get him a letter to send to corporate for approval which Brian is working at getting for me. If this is the case we will have about 4 of the 7 sets of jerseys paid for.
